To complete the survey:

- Go to any computer that has an up-to-date internet browser access at home, work, or school. Go to <u>www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey/access.htm</u>
- 2. Complete the survey by clicking on the "radio buttons" for each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on NEXT in the bottom right corner of the screen.
- 3. When you are finished the survey you will get a message "Thank you for sharing your views".
- 4. If you feel you made a mistake, repeat the procedure above.
- 5. Once complete, your school will have the results immediately.

The information gathered from students, parents/guardians, and staff provides valuable feedback to the schools regarding our annual School Plans, School Goals, programming for specialized services, and resource allocations targets.
