Life Touch Notice

The health, safety and well-being of everyone in the schools we visit is our top priority. We want to share with you some of the enhanced cleaning protocols we are implementing for Picture Day to ensure camera stations are sanitized and safe for students.

You'll notice the following enhanced cleaning protocols on Picture Day:

- Sanitizing wipes and sprays will be used on all set-up materials and equipment at the beginning and end of day.
- During photography, equipment used or touched by subjects will be sanitized.
- Pre-moistened alcohol wipes will be used on the camera's viewfinder and high-touch areas on the camera.
- Hand Sanitizer will be frequently used by our photographers throughout the day.

• Please plan to drop your child(ren) off and pick them up as close to the bell as possible to minimize traffic on the school grounds. Teachers will inform students which door to meet at in the morning in order to ensure safe distances between learning groups.

Pick-up

• Fairview staff will dismiss students at 2:25 pm each day and naturally this will lead to high traffic areas. We want to keep everyone safe. This will require our entire community to practice and model safe social distancing. Remember, children are always looking to adults as a model of how to behave appropriately. Our staff will do everything they can to educate students about safe social distancing after school. Additionally, you will receive this information from your classroom teacher via e-mail. Please arrange a safe pick-up plan with your child and re-iterate the importance of keeping a safe distance.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS



SD 68 is committed to promoting Safe Schools for all students and staff. Part of that commitment is ensuring staff and students are trained and prepared to respond to any threat, minor or serious, to our school population. To this end SD 68 staff and students periodically conduct 'practice drills' to simulate effective responses to potential safety threats. These drills are similar to our fire and earthquake drills with an added focus on staying safe within the school building.

Should you arrive at your child's school during such a practice, please follow instructions that will be posted at the entrance to the school.

At this time, only students and staff are able to enter the building. If you need to reach your child or child's teacher, please contact the office. Children's safety is our first priority.

LUNCHES, MESSAGES, ETC ...

The time we have with your children for teaching and learning is precious and must be protected. It is our common expectation at Fairview that we not interrupt teaching time. Each interruption affects the flow of a lesson and the creative thinking of students, and it can be a challenge to re-establish that flow. For this reason we all request that you please send a note in your child's planner if there is something your child's teacher needs to know (appointment, early pickup, etc.) or leave a message with the office staff. Also, please send filled water bottles to school. Bottles will be able to be refilled at school but fountains are closed for use.

School Cash Online - District News
